

Hopping or Dancing, Nose Twitching, Curiosity and Exploration, Relaxed Postures, Licking and Affection


Tiptoeing and Alert Posture

A cautious rabbit will slowly tip-toe around with their ears forward and their tails down.

Signs of an Unhappy Rabbit

Thumping or Stomping, Teeth Grinding, Flattening, Aggressive Stances, Boxing or Lunging, Foot Flicking, Showing Teeth, Freezing in Place
